Our Curriculum

This term in English, we will be reading The Worrysaurus, Clean Up! and Cake as well as other exciting stories. Maths will mainly focus on place value.

In science, children will study habitats. They will learn about the plants and animals in the ocean habitat and compare this with a woodland habitat.

In history, we will study the lives of significant people, namely Mary Anning and David Attenborough. Geography will focus on looking at our local area and the human and physical features and in art, children will be exploring 3d sculpture.
